TYPES OF HOME CARE PROVIDED BY

PERSONAL CARE



Support for Daily Living

Non-medical assistance with personal care, housekeeping, transportation, and social interaction. Typically paid privately or through long-term care insurance.

PRIVATE DUTY NURSING



Skilled Medical and Personal Care

Medical and non-medical support provided by nurses or aides for complex health needs. Paid out-of-pocket or through long-term care insurance.



HOME HEALTH CARE



Short-term Medical Rehabilitation Physician-directed medical care focused on recovery and rehabilitation. Often covered by Medicare or insurance.
